## Canadian Open BBQ Championships What this Competition is all About - FAQ

### When is this event held?

The official event date is Saturday, June 19<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010. However teams will complete set up and will begin cooking on Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

### Where is this event held?

### What categories will teams compete in?

Teams competing for Grand Champion must compete in the Brisket, Chicken, Open Pork and Pork Rib categories. Grand Champion will be selected by the team with the highest overall points with all 4 categories combined.

In addition, teams can choose to compete in 3 other categories: Sauce, Dessert & Anything But.

Lastly, there is a general category which teams can compete and that is in for Best Booth. Teams will dress up their booth in themes which makes their booth more appealing to the judges and to the public at the event. Judges will vote for which one they think is best.

### What will teams win?

What is the turn-in time format?

Turn-in times for the blind submissions will take place from 5 minutes to the hour until 5 minutes after the hour (ex: 1:55 to 2:05, 3:55 to 4:05, etc.).

Onsite judging will commence at each team's site at quarter past the hour (ex: 2:15, 4:15, etc.).

What makes this event unique?

The type of judging we use!

### **On-Site**

Two judges will visit a team's booth for each category. They will be presented with the same dish including sides that the team has submitted for Blind Judging. These judges will be 'wined and dined' by the teams. Judges will be rotated so that they do not judge the same team on site during the competition.

### **Blind**

Each team will present four similar entries using the 9"x9" styrofoam containers provided by the organizers which will be evaluated by four different judges. Judges will only know dishes based on a double-blind coding system.

How will team's turn-ins be judged?

All entries will be judged on Presentation (15 Points), Taste of the Main Dish (70 points) and Taste of the Side Dish (15 Points).
